Ce faisant, il a brisé maints tabous et "décanonisé" l'histoire du monde musulman, telle qu'elle a été présentée par la pensée traditionnelle. Il n'a pas proposé un schéma de reconstruction du monde musulman ou un prototype de l'homme musulman, mais leur a indiqué des voies et une vocation. Il a enrichi les sciences sociales d'une meilleure connaissance de la psychologie et de la sociologie musulmanes et fourni une interprétation de l'histoire musulmane dont nous avons besoin aujourd'hui pour réconcilier

He is also a poet and novelist; his version of the Gigamesh epic was a nominee for the

 Revival and Reform in Islam is at once an intellectual biography of Muhammad al-Shawkani, and a history of a transitional period in Yemeni history. This was a time when a society dominated by traditional Zaydi Shiism shifted to one characterised instead by Sunni reformism. The author traces the origins and outcomes of this transition, presenting the first systematic account of the ways in which the eighteenth- and nineteenth-century reorientation of the Zaydi madhhab, and consequent sunnification of Yemeni society, were intricately linked to tensions within the political realm.
